MEDIEVAL GHENT



HIGHLIGHTS ON THIS TOUR

Guided city walk in the centre of Ghent – visit of the St. Bavo's Cathedral housing the Mystic Lamb

DURATION AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Approx. 4 hours – departure time at 09:15 – max 45 pax

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Upon arrival in the beautiful city of Ghent, follow your guide for a city walk starting at St. Michael's Bridge, where you will have an impressive view of the historic centre. See the Old Port area with its gabled guild houses, the age-old Castle of the Counts and the famous row of the three towers – St. Nicholas Church, Belfry Tower and St. Bavo's Cathedral. This last one houses the world famous Ghent Altarpiece 'the Mystic Lamb' painted by the brothers Van Eyck. Follow your guide for a visit through the impressive cathedral and feast your eyes on this impressive painting.

Belgium's landmark Atomium – Royal Palace of Laeken – Cinquantenaire Arcade – Japanese Tower

Upon arrival in the capital of Belgium, you will enjoy a panoramic drive past the King Boudoin Stadium and the Centenaire and make a short photo stop at the Atomium statue that was built for the World Expo of '58. Continuing on, you will view the Chinese Pavilion, the Japanese Tower and the Royal Castle of Laeken. Upon conclusion, the coach will bring you to Brussels Airport.

Flemish Primitives – top 18th and 19th-century neoclassical pieces

DURATION AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Pay a visit to the Groeningemuseum, located on the former site of the Eekhoutabdij (Eekhout Abbey). This museum offers a varied overview of the history of Belgian plastic arts. Although the Flemish Primitives are a high point, you will also marvel at top 18th and 19th-century neoclassical pieces, masterpieces from Flemish Expressionism and post-war modern art.
